There are a number of available programs from the federal, state and local levels, which can help pay the medical bills for individuals or families who have low income and cannot afford medical care.

Below you will find information on the various assistance and community outreach programs. ### Medicaid

---

[Medicaid](#) is the State and Federal cooperative venture that provides medical coverage to eligible needy persons. ### Crime Victims

Texas courts collect court costs from convicted offenders for the [Crime Victims' Compensation Fund](#). If you are a victim of violent crime, you may be eligible for benefits.

### The County Indigent Health Care Program

---

[County Indigent Health Care Program](#) provides health care services to eligible residents through the counties, hospital districts and public hospitals in Texas. Counties that are not fully served by a public facility (i.e., a hospital district or a public hospital) are responsible for

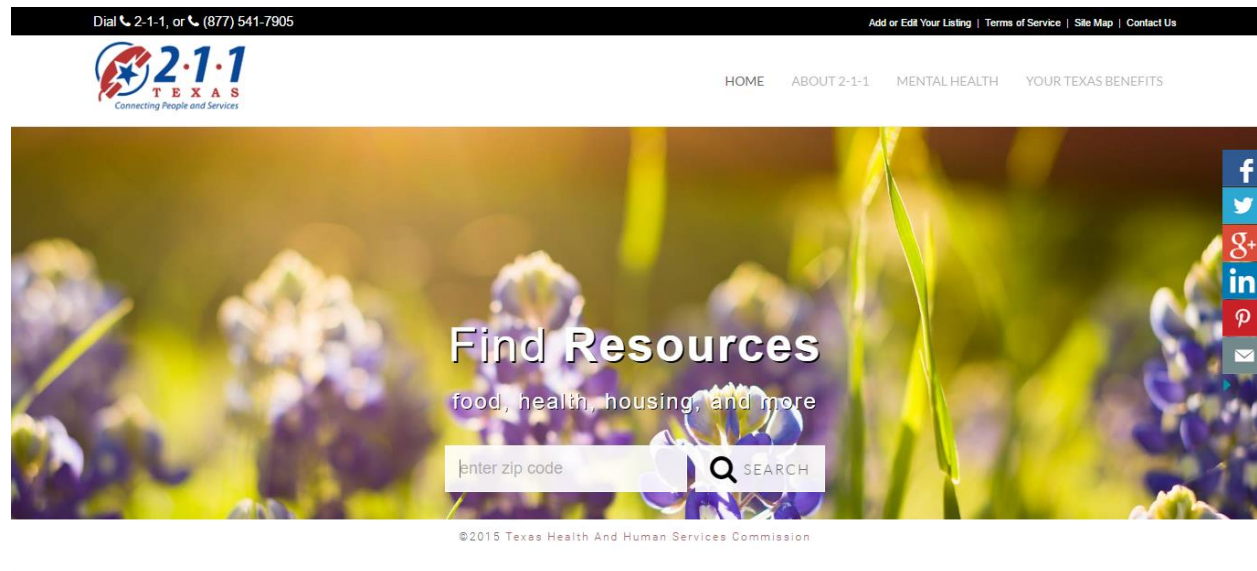
administering an indigent health care program for eligible residents of all or any portion of the county not served by a public facility.
